

NAMES FROM THE SIGNET DOCUMENTS OF HENRY V (1413-1422)

This article collects given names and place names extracted from the *Anthology of Chancery English* (Knoxville: University of Tennessee Press, 1984), a collection of transcriptions of Middle English and Latin documents. This article is limited to names from the reign of Henry V (1413-1422), and includes place names from locations in France, Wales and England.

The *Anthology* preserves the original spellings and has not modernized the names. Letters in parenthesis are editorial guesses by the compilers of the *Anthology* in instances when the original text is illegible.

Almost every name in the data follows the pattern *[given name] + [surname]*. The only other patterns are *[given name] + [locative byname]* and *[given name] + [surname] + [locative byname]*, both of which appear multiple times. Both *de* and *of* are used with locatives. I have included locative bynames in the surname data in cases where they are found specifically in names. Otherwise, place names are listed separately.

Where women are mentioned, in all but one instance they are mentioned in the same sentence as their husbands and referred to merely as “his wife” without a surname or byname of their own. One woman, Margerye Deye, is identified by her full name.

Variant spellings are listed together, with the most common variant listed first.
